Peanut Butter Banana Treats

Ingredients:

1 peeled banana
1 egg
1 cup flour
 $\frac{2}{3}$ cup rolled oats
4 tablespoons, natural,
unsweetened peanut butter

Directions:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees
In a large bowl, mash banana; add remaining ingredients and combine
Roll mixture into small balls, using about 1 tablespoon of dough for each.

Place on a parchment-lined baking sheet, and use a fork to press down slightly and flatten into disks. Bake 40 minutes or until light brown and crunchy.
